COVID-19: THE SAFETY OF CASH

HOW LONG DO VIRUSES LIVE?



FLU VIRUSES

- Hard surfaces (plastics and metals) for up to 48 hours
- Porous surfaces (paper and cloth) for 8 to 10 hours



SARS-CoV-2 (the virus responsible for COVID-19)

- Hard surfaces (plastics and metals) for up to 3 days
- Porous surfaces (paper and cloth) for 24 hours

WHAT ARE THEY MADE OF?

- US currency is 75% cotton and 25% linen
- Euro banknotes are 100% cotton fiber
- **SABN** is made of cotton pulp

- **Canada currency** is made from synthetic polymer
- British banknotes are made from a thermoplastic polymer

CASH IN USE

- Cash is used for 45%-54% of transactions in European countries with the least cash use.
- Cash accounts for 50% of payments in the US under \$10.
- Cash makes up 18%-20% of payments in Latin America.
